Develop process improvement recommendations and assist in implementation.

Requirements Gathering and Analysis

Use various techniques (e.g., interviews, workshops, surveys) to gather requirements.

Create detailed use cases, user stories, and support workstreams to baseline benefits

Design and facilitate workshops to engage staff to understand root cause issues

Data Analysis and presentation

Analyse data to identify trends, patterns, and insights

Use data analysis tools and techniques (e.g., SQL, Excel, BI tools) to extract and manipulate data.

Develop data-driven insights and recommendations to support decision-making.

Create materials and presentations to support decision-making.

Project Management Support

Assist project managers in planning, scheduling, and tracking project activities.
